The standards of care will be at the highest level and the clinical staff will be publishing case studies as well as conducting randomized clinical trials. It really is a dream come true.

I have never been so excited about anything in my life. We finally will have a University based Clinic that will also serve to train our diplomates with a variety of extended residency programs. DC students will be given access to observe real patient treatment starting in the first quarter. The Life University Neurology Club members will be given access to train with the attending specialists.

I have agreed to attend patients at the University Clinic personally. I will consult with difficult cases at the Life Functional Neurology Clinic rather than at the Hospitals and Universities where I have currently seen patients over the last many years. This venture is something that I had to support, it is meaningful and will make a difference in the training of diplomats and fellows, but more importantly it will make a difference in the status of our discipline.

I have no administrative position in this venture, neither am I an officer of the Life Functional Neurology Clinic. So, I have no financial obligations, nor decisions to make---other than attending difficult neurological cases and assisting others in developing strategies that will enable them to serve humankind better.

There will be further opportunities for Diplomates

to become attending clinicians at the clinic. We expect a dynamic residency program and those who are in the Carrick Institute Graduate School Neurology programs will be able to serve extended residencies, contribute to their training and CV and be a part of a major thrust at the University.

Under the leadership of Dr. Guy Riekeman, Life University has embraced a functional neurological model of chiropractic. We are living in an amazing time and history is being made. This project is a primary concern in the mission of the University and we all can be a part of it.

If you have a difficult neurological case then consider referring the patient to the Life University Functional Neurology Clinic. The patient will be examined and tested and you will receive direction on patient care. You can also send the patient to the University for Diagnosis and neurological treatment and you can attend with your patient and observe and participate. Diplomates and Learners with the Carrick Institute will be given priority for their patient care to allow you to have your patients seen as quickly as possible.

We will be posting more as the Clinic develops. There are over 100 ongoing research projects already in motion. The Clinic is already attending professional athletes and celebrities and has a major concussion clinic for professional athletes already fully booked in January. Excitement is around.

I urge you to be a part of this dream, a dream that will establish a world class Functional Neurology Clinic at an Accredited University. The Clinic is already receiving referrals from the medical community, not only in Georgia but from International venues as well. I could not refuse supporting this project when asked to participate by Dr. Riekeman.

If you have difficult patients that you need to see, you can call Tricia Merlin at the Carrick Institute. She can assist you with introductions, procedures and phone contacts for patient scheduling. She is personally in charge of my schedule if you would ever desire your patients to be seen by me.

Life University is already planning a major expansion of the clinic and has purchased a major lot of land where they will be building a Functional Neurology Center from the ground up. This is expected to be completed in 2 years. History today, and we are all blessed to witness it. I hope it is as great as the dreams that have made it real.
